
# **St James's Nursery News**

### **December Learning Focus**



Theme: Sparkle and Shine; It's Christmas Time!

Colours: Red, Silver and Gold

**Shape:** Star

In the run up to Christmas, children will enjoy many seasonal experiences relating to the holiday.

As well as decorating the Nursery with festivate decorations, children will participate in writing and posting letters to Santa. They will partake in seasonal role play at the Christmas Market and Santa's Workshop. There will be lots of festive arts and crafts and a range of seasonal tuff tray, sand, water and play dough activities.

Children will get the opportunity to listen to and join in with a variety of Christmas songs and use a range of instruments during their Christmas Concert practices and show.

We will learn about the Nativity and the first Christmas story, as well as other cultural Christmas traditions such as Santa, The North Pole, Rudolph and many more.

Our Maths focus will centre around number recognition and correspondence for numbers 1-5.

The Education Authority Admissions Portal opens at 12 noon on Tuesday 9th January 2024 and closes at 12 noon on Friday 26th January 2024.

The admissions process is completed by parents/guardians online using the portal. Please ensure that you refer to our admissions criteria when making your application. If you have any difficulties with your application, please contact Mrs Brown in the school office.


## St James's PS & NU Value of the Month
