


St James's Nursery News

November Learning Focus



Theme: Off We Go - Transport, Nursery Rhymes and Space

Colours: Black, Blue, Yellow

Shape: Rectangle, Star

This month we are focusing on different types of transportation, learning about road safety and exploring the theme of Space.

As the weather changes and the evenings get darker more quickly, we will focus on exploring the concept of dark and light in a variety of ways. We will discuss personal safety and the importance of being seen in the dark.

Children will freely investigate dark and light concepts while handling torches, lights and mirrors. They will use the light table to experiment with opaque, translucent and reflective materials to make observations, as well as experience the sensation of darkness inside a blackout tent.

To tie in with World Nursery Rhyme Week we will be practising lots of traditional rhymes through our play activities. We are also organising a very special parent and child event with Moo Music on Friday 10th November with more details on this to follow.

Please note a few meetings will take place on the Tuesday.


St James's PS & NU Value of the Month

Eating some most delicious bugs.


Yum yum!
