Children will get the opportunity to explore our theme through a variety of heart crafts, baking experiences and mark making opportunities.

We will also learn this month about the importance of keeping our heart happy through healthy eating choices. Children will 'taste the rainbow' through a variety of fruits and vegetables, and will begin to identify and categorise some of these.

The Big Bedtime Read - reminder



We cannot give out a new book pack until the previous pack has been returned, thank you.


St James's PS & NU Value of the Month
